## Planned and temporary loss of power to Leeton District Hospital from 8.00am – 10.00am on Wednesday 11 December 2024

# Health Infrastructure is installing three modern key worker accommodation units at Leeton District Hospital to assist with the recruitment and retention of health workers.

Health Infrastructure has engaged Hutchinson Builders to carry out the work which includes the temporary loss of power to Leeton District Hospital to enable the connection of the Key Worker Accommodation power supply to the hospital's Main Switch Board (MSB).

Work times will be between 8.00am and 10.00am on Wednesday 11 December 2024. We will let you know in advance of any changes to these days and times.

Installation of the key worker accommodation units started on 3 December and is expected to be completed by early 2025 ready for the first key workers to move in.

#### How will this work affect you?

We recognise that building new infrastructure can be disruptive to staff, patients, visitors, nearby residents, businesses and road users. All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority.

This Works Notice is to inform of the following impacts:

- An electrician will be connecting a new power supply feed to the MSB, requiring temporary isolation of all electrical services, resulting in the hospital being without power for approximately two hours at the times noted above.
- This will impact most services requiring electricity, including lights, power points, lift services and hot water services.
- Please use stairs at this time as the lift will be out of service. Breakfast will be served to patients at 7.45am so kitchen staff can use the lift to deliver breakfast.
- Please ensure any mobile phones, laptops and any other electronic devices are fully charged before 8.00am.

Generators will be provided to power any essential equipment required during this period, including refrigeration and medical equipment.

The automatic entry doors will be kept open with monitoring by hospital security and the Ambulance entry doors will be set to manual.

IT and phone services will not be impacted.

Patients will be advised of the power outage and impacts via a Notice on their dinner tray on Tuesday 10 December.

Visitors and the community will also be advised via signs in public areas of the hospital, MLHD social media and a print ad in the Leeton Irrigator local newspaper.

You are also advised that the road leading into the hospital site from Myall Street will be closed on Friday 6 December to enable the construction of a trench for the power infrastructure to be laid – see map below. Please use the two alternative entrances at this time.
