





- Collaboration with our partners is key to the continued successful delivery of an increasing volume of work.




NSW Budget




The forecast is unprecedented

CAPITAL BUDGET (\$ MILLIONS)






Work packages 2021/22





Ten Point Plan

- 1. Procure and manage projects in a more collaborative way.
- 2. Adopt partnership-based approaches to risk allocation.
- 3. Standardise contracts and procurement methods.
- 4. Develop and promote a transparent pipeline of projects.
- 5. Reduce the cost of bidding.
- 6. Establish a consistent NSW Government policy on bid cost contributions.
- 7. Monitor and reward high performance.
- 8. Improve the security and timeliness of contract payments.
- 9. Improve skills and training.
- 10. Increase industry diversity.



Procurement panel

- Health Infrastructure Construction Services Contractor Procurement List – launched August 2020 for works valued \$9 million and over
- The first tranche of contractors are now pre-qualified
- List now reopened and you may apply at any time.
