

Noise and vibration impact to SARU and Oncology on west side of Broken Hill Hospital campus on **Wednesday 31 July 2024**

Health Infrastructure is building a new Acute Mental Health Inpatient Unit and refurbishing the Emergency Department at Broken Hill Hospital to better meet the health needs of the Broken Hill community now and into the future.

We recognise that building new infrastructure can be disruptive to consumers, visitors, staff, nearby residents, businesses and road users. All construction activities are carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority. For your safety, please follow instructions at all times.

Construction on the Acute Mental Health Inpatient Unit has now commenced. Health Infrastructure has engaged Barpa Construction Services to carry out this work.

How does this work affect you?

This Notification is to advise that there will be noisy demolition work taking place in the SARU and Oncology carpark on **Wednesday 31 July, between 8.00am and 5.00pm**. This area is already fenced off as part of the construction zone. See map for impacted area outlined in green.

This work requires concrete sawing and jack hammering to break up the concrete carpark into sections for removal.

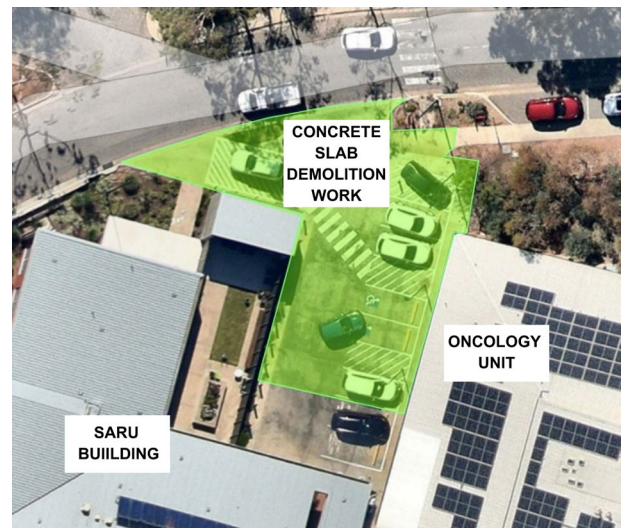
Sawing will commence at 8.00am and jack hammering will take place between 9.00am – midday and 2.00pm – 5.00pm.

Water will be used to suppress dust. Some vibration can be expected.

Note the demolition contractor will begin clearing roadways and kerbs on Monday 29 July – there are no impacts to hospital users prior to the demolition works on Wednesday 31 July.
