BESIX Watpac are currently undertaking the dedicated environmental inspections on a monthly basis. Inspections occurring at weekly or daily are primarily safety related, but include checks on housekeeping, dewatering, spill kits and permits. Section 6.2 of the CEMP requires weekly environmental and the ESCP requires weekly and pre and post wet weather inspections. These have only occurred through the daily inspections, checking on dewatering, rather than adequacy of controls. Notwithstanding this the controls on site appeared to align with the ESCP and were well installed.
